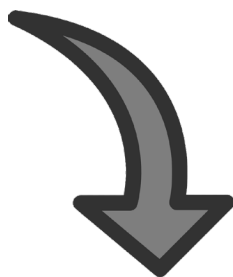
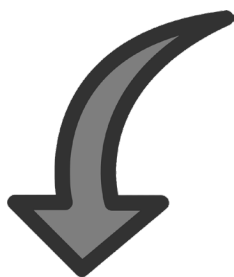

It's our friends and our families, the ones we hold dear.

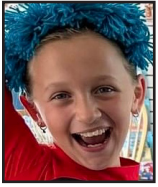
You, yes you! The final piece of our show,

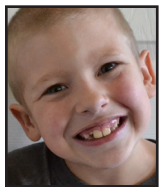

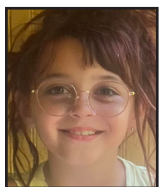

thank Jen Neff and his sister Ella for their encouragement and help along the way.

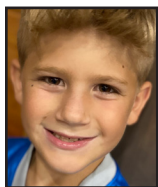

with her friends. She would like to thank her family for supporting her and taking her to practices and thanks her directors and all the actors for this fun opportunity!



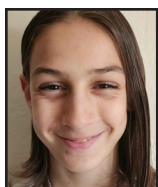

watch and she thanks the directors and crew for all of their guidance.

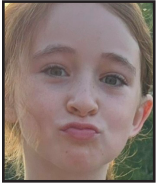
